

MEETING REPORT for OCTOBER 2025



October each year sees us devote the whole meeting to celebrating a "does anyone want to form a garden club in Robina" meeting held in October 1994.

The eighteen people who came said yes and initiated the incorporation of the new **Robina Garden Club** Inc. In February 1995 the first formal meeting was held and now, 31 years later, the club is still going.
