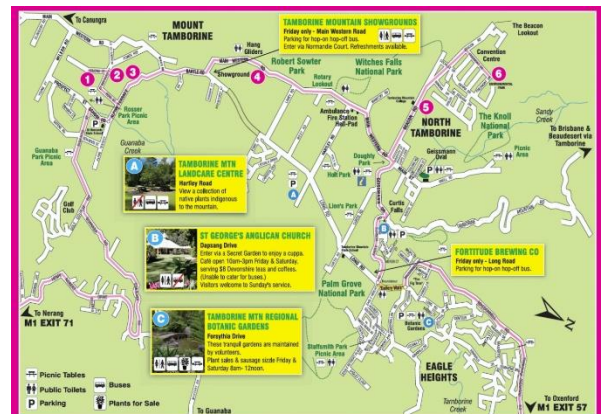

in the spectacular Scenic Rim

1 WILMONT Benowa Street This park-like garden is steeped in the history of the early days of European settlement on Tamborine Mountain. Remnant rainforest trees and the black smithing shed hint at the history. Now the fragrant scent of roses wafts your way. Colourful annuals and perennials delight. More surprises await from the interactive wood working shed to the productive fruit and vegetable plantings. <i>Flat, grassed, some wheelchair access.</i>	2 FIVE TREES ESTATE St Bernards Street Graceful camellias, magnolias and miniature agapanthus beckon on entering this broad, spacious garden. Following the grassed watercourse, gently curved mounds guide you past Banksia rose, flowering peaches, ibis, daisies, Dutch iris, statice, impatiens, poppies and dianthus. Pause at the formal vegetable beds before making your way to the arch bridge in the serene Japanese garden. <i>Gentle grassy slopes, not suitable for wheelchairs.</i>	3 CHALK HOUSE Alpine Terrace Native plants and trees create a distinctive Australian contemporary garden. Repeated plantings of beautifully rounded westringias and casuarinas contrast peacefully against the straggly leaves of native and exotic grasses and bulbous lilies. Stroll up from the vegetable plot, past sculptures by TM Arts Collective artists to discover hidden garden rooms. Art works for sale. <i>Gentle slopes, limited wheelchair access.</i>
4 ADAMAH Main Western Road Four years ago, the owners planted 1800 tube stock amongst remnant tall-woods and fooded gums. Today walk through this inspiring regenerated rainforest covering 2.5 acres of a former avocado farm. An ancient strangler fig stands guard over the remaining avocados and the more recently planted fruit trees. Do not miss the thriving vegetable patch and chicken run as you exit the hidden sanctuary. <i>Flat, mulched paths, wheelchair accessible.</i>	5 BELICIA Beacon Road Enter via a shaded woodland, past flowering blueberries to spy the red and purple lilies, irises and brunellias. The Wisteria Walk leads to the blues, whites and greys of the intensely planted terrace garden. Beyond, raised vegetable beds, a chicken house, fruit and nut trees amongst swathes of daylilies, kniphofia and alstroemeria await. <i>Flat, grassed with gravel and mulch paths, some wheelchair access.</i>	6 CAMELLIA COTTAGE Freemont Drive Grassy slopes and pathways lead past citrus trees to the arching branches of mature camellias. Majestic eucalypts create the backdrop in this established garden bordering a national park. Catch glimpses of the ranges to the west as you wander amongst clipped azaleas, giant orchids, salvia, begonias & lilies ensuring year-round colour. <i>Gentle slopes, pathways and stone steps not suitable for wheelchairs.</i>
